An excellent introduction to counselling skills

This course will enable learners to develop skills in helping others by introducing some of the key counselling skills that support the helping process.

It is widely applicable to many professionals who listen to people and provide help and support including appropriate signposting. Previous attendees have included social workers, support workers, volunteers, health professionals and private sector workers.

- The skills necessary for the management of interviews using counselling skills.
- The process of change and loss.
